We are soliciting applications/nominations from IEEE PES members of good standing for the position of Editor-in-Chief of IEEE Power & Energy Magazine. The position will be effective from July 2025 or soon after that. The term of the appointment will be for three years with the possibility of extension for a second three-year term. This is a part-time paid position reporting to the PES VP of Publications and PES Executive Director as an independent contractor. The position will require approximately 25 - 28 hours per week.

The award-winning IEEE Power & Energy Magazine is a bimonthly magazine dedicated to disseminating information on all matters of interest to electric power engineers and other professionals involved in the electric power industry. Feature articles focus on advanced concepts, technologies, and practices associated with all aspects of electric power from a technical perspective in synergy with nontechnical areas such as business, environmental, and social concerns. IEEE Power & Energy Magazine keeps its readers up to date on the latest technological advancements, industry news, business trends and strategies, products, and publications. Important newsworthy items concerning the worldwide activities and achievements of PES, its organizational units, and its individual members are included. The publication is available in a printed copy and on the web.

Job Description:

The responsibilities of the Editor in Chief (EIC) include the following:

- Setting the tone of the magazine and its mission, scope, and vision,
- Soliciting content for magazine columns, including creating new columns,
- Identifying suitable members for the editorial board and managing recruitment process
- Managing the editorial organization and the editorial board
- Finding and working with guest editors to solicit feature articles for planned themed issues,
- Liaising with dedicated promoting/advertising partners and overseeing the process of soliciting advertisements and promoting the magazine
- Developing plans for future issue themes of the magazine,
- Manage the Transmission & Distribution and Grid Edge Conferences Special Issues of P&E Magazine (i.e., overseeing the whole process and appointing a Guest EIC who will spearhead the special issue and appoint a committee to solicit and review the articles.)
- Prepare editorial content sufficient for six issues annually, totaling 560 pages annually.
- Managing the publication cycle of each issue of the magazine.
 - Decide on content for each issue and the order of articles
 - Ensure that relevant content is timely and technically accurate.
 - Write the Editor's Voice article for each issue.
 - Manage peer review process for feature articles and columns using relevant IEEE PES web interface and PES Publication Board guidelines.
 - Manage the review of and response to non-solicited articles to the magazine in accordance to PES Publication Board guidelines.
 - Ensure that each issue is submitted to IEEE Publications on time by sending finalized submission material to the IEEE Publishing managing editor by set deadline.
 - Approving the cover and reviewing the proof of each issue prior to publication.

Application/nomination materials must include the following information.

Part A: The essential minimum requirements that all applicants should fulfil, and which should be covered by enclosed CV include

- Previous experience as an editor or Editor in Chief or Senior Editor (or similar) of professional or commercial publications, especially magazines.
- Experience with PEM contributions as a guest editor and/or feature article author.
- Well-connected to industry, technical, commercial, and society leaders.
- Track record in ability to make effective contacts, solicit other connections, and otherwise support the production of quality content for the magazine.
- Team leadership experience and management experience.
- Being an IEEE Power & Energy Society (PES) Senior member, Fellow or Life Fellow in good standing.
 - Broad knowledge of the PES organization structure
 - Familiarity with PES leadership structure
- Broad knowledge of the power & energy field including,
 - The various PES technical areas and technical challenges of power system control, operations, planning, and regulations
 - The types of power system organizations such as independent operating utilities, municipal utilities, rural-electric cooperatives, regional transmission organization and independent system operators, and distribution system operators,
 - The technology solution providers,
 - The types of industry regulators,
 - The technical and business luminaries of the field
- Strong writing skills and ability to communicate complex issues in an understandable and accessible way to a broad audience
- Proven editorial skills for constructively addressing content and formatting shortcomings and providing direction to authors

Part B: Application/nomination materials must include the following information:

1. Prior service on an IEEE Editorial Board. (List the 3 most recent positions including experience with PEM contributions as a guest editor and/or feature article author.)
2. Technical Committee activity. (List the 3 most recent activities.)
3. Three to five (maximum) areas of research/professional expertise.
4. Track record in ability to make effective contacts, solicit other connections, and otherwise support the production of quality content for the magazine (List the 3 most recent activities/positions)
5. IEEE Region (1-10)
6. Profession Sector (academia, utility, manufacturer, government, vendor, research institute, other.)
7. Names and contact information of three (3) references.
8. Resume/CV (max 2-pages) addressing directly the essential criteria specified in Part A.

The deadline for receipt of all materials is 25th May 2025. The CV (max 2 pages) and application letter (max 2 pages) should be sent as a single pdf document to: **PESEICapp@ieee.org** with the journal title you are applying or being nominated for and your name in the following format **PEM-EIC Application-Name Surname.pdf**

Part C: The process:

An EIC search committee chaired by the PES VP of publications and comprising a combination of industrial representatives having different affiliation, expertise and experience and members of PES Publication Board will review all the nominees/applicants. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed further by the committee to assess their leadership visions and strategies for the magazine. The committee makes a recommendation to the PES President who confirms the appointment
